We will do this by making it easier for people to

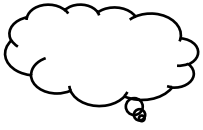
- be included in activities and services

accountability	To be willing to explain what we do and why we do it.

community	The people and places around where you live.
connection	Being able to do things with other people.
Community Vision	A document that says how the people in Nillumbik would like life to be in the future.
resilience	Being able to cope well when bad or difficult things happen.
responsibility	If you have responsibility for a job or a person, you must make sure the <ul style="list-style-type: none">• job is done• person is looked after.
sustainability	When you try to reduce things that cause damage to the planet, such as <ul style="list-style-type: none">• using less fuel like coal or gas• making less waste.
