Eligibility

- Incorporated non-profit community groups/organisations or unincorporated groups which are auspiced by an incorporated body that will deliver activities/projects in Nillumbik.
- Minimum \$10 million public liability insurance and a certificate of currency.
- No outstanding grant acquittals from a previous Nillumbik Shire Council grant.

Exclusions

Grants will not be considered for:

- Ongoing organisational operating costs
- Projects that have received full funding from another source
- Venues that are not accessible e.g. no lift or accessible toilet
- Retrospective funding or projects which are not being run during the 16 Days campaign

Applications will close on Friday 20 September 2019.
